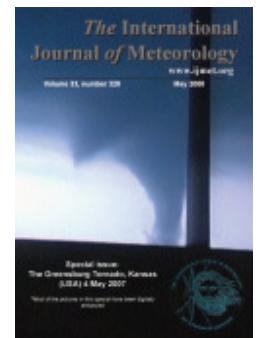

**Terms and Notes:** There are currently usually 10 issues per year. Year 2010 there will be 12 issues commencing with Volume 35, Issue 345 and ending with 357 (subject to change due to the nature of our organisation). If we are able to produce 12 issues (as is planned this celebratory year) no further charge will be made. Cancellations are accepted. Subscriptions are payable in advance. Email orders and PayPal payments are encouraged. Limited back issues are available at an extra cost of £7.50 each for non-subscribers and £5.00 each for subscribers. Contact us for details if back issues are required mid-year. Whatever your requirements, we are happy to assist and will do our best to accommodate your needs. Subscriptions begin on the month payment is made, if that month's Journal is already dispatched, subscriptions begin the following month. Renewals are requested two months before subscription ends. If renewals are made later than the subscription month, the month you pay in will become the new renewal month and journals from unpaid months will be missed in the dispatch. If you want to purchase those missing journals either an extra postage charge will be made or back issue costs apply, (dependent on how late the renewal is).
