There are currently usually 10 issues per year (12 online). Year 2011 commences with Volume 36, Issue 358 and ends with 367 (subject to change due to the nature of our organisation). If we are able to produce 12 printed issues no further charge will be applied. Cancellations are accepted. Subscriptions are payable in advance. Email/fax orders and PayPal payments are encouraged. Limited back issues are available at an extra cost of £7.50 each for non-subscribers and £5.00 each for subscribers. Contact us for details if back issues are required mid-year.
